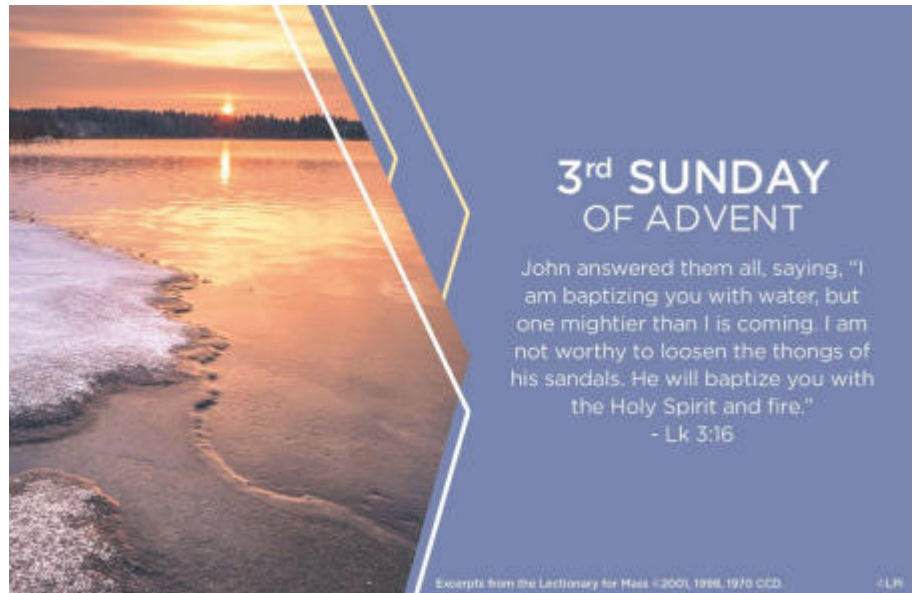

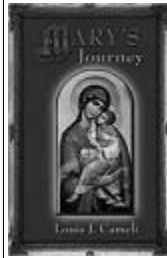
VITA NOVA MEN'S RETREAT
