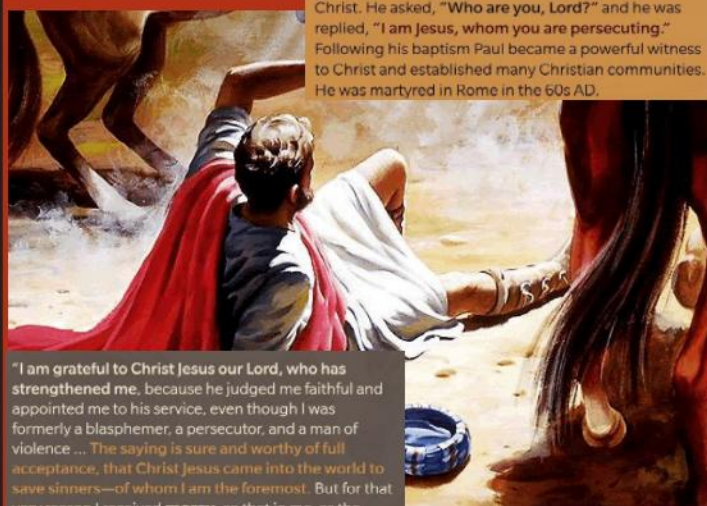

WHO WAS PAUL?

St. Paul was formerly known as Saul, a violent persecutor of the Lord’s disciples. On his way to arrest them in Damascus, the risen Christ appeared to him in a brilliant light and said: “Saul, Saul why do you persecute me?” Saul was blinded by the light that was Christ. He asked, “Who are you, Lord?” and he was replied, “I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.” Following his baptism Paul became a powerful witness to Christ and established many Christian communities. He was martyred in Rome in the 60s AD.



“I am grateful to Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because he judged me faithful and appointed me to his service, even though I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and a man of violence ... The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the foremost. But for that very reason I received **mercy**, so that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display the utmost patience, making me an example to those who would come to believe in him for eternal life. To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honour and glory forever and ever. Amen.” -St. Paul (1 TIMOTHY 1:12-17)

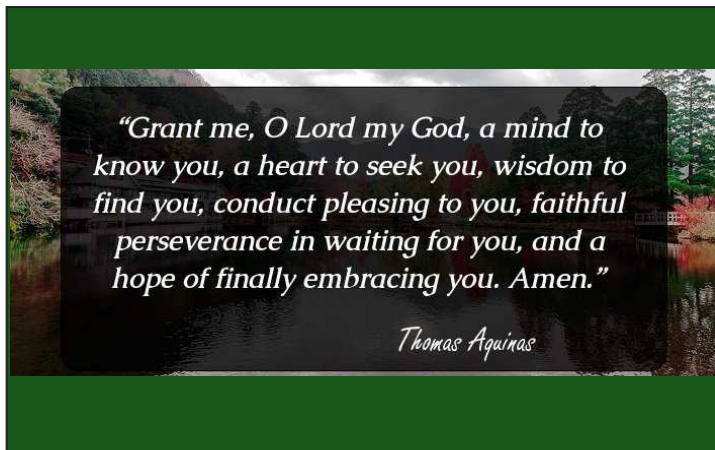
